



Autism Treatment Network Research Repository

We are asking families of children with autism spectrum disorders (ASD) who are being seen in Vanderbilt University clinics to participate in a new repository with the Autism Treatment Network (ATN). The purpose of this repository is to have a way to store information so that we can gain a better understanding of the medical concerns that may be associated with ASD, such as sleep disorders and digestive problems.

This repository will contain health facts on individuals with ASD. Vanderbilt is one of 15 sites across the US and Canada that will be part of the ATN repository. We hope to develop standards of care and treatment protocols for those with ASD. If your child is between the ages of 3-17 years, you may be eligible. There is no compensation for your participation in this repository.

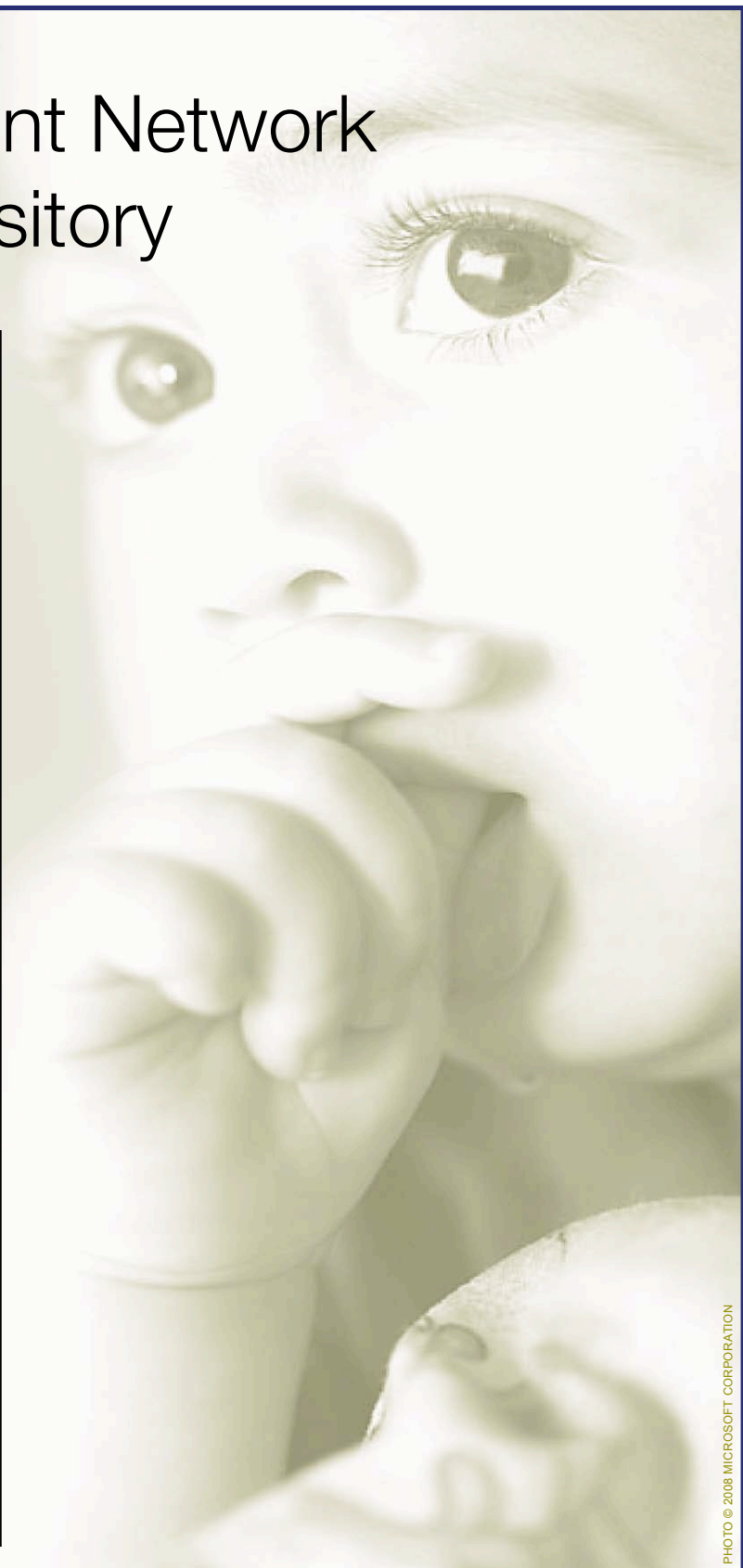


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
