

School-to-Adult Transitions Clinic at Vanderbilt

The **School-to-Adult Transitions Clinic at Vanderbilt (SAT-V)** helps young adults with intellectual disabilities, ages 17-25, cope with the challenges involved in successfully transitioning from the school to after-school years. Change can be difficult and sometimes may be associated with emotional and behavior concerns that cause problems in daily living. Clinic staff will assist in facilitating positive changes to help people get a positive start on adulthood.
